

This is the order of presentations in each group. We'll go through as many each day that we can get through. This means you should be ready to present each day. Talks should be a maximum of 12 minutes (you will be cut off after 12 minutes) with 5 minutes for questions. Given a minute or so for transition from speaker to speaker, we should be able to get 5-6 speakers each session. Keep in mind, someone before you could be a no-show or end early, which moves your talk forward. Deviations from this schedule or topics should be approved by the leader of your Presentation Group (Bart or Warren). Remember, Bart's group will meet in the classroom, and Warren's group will meet in FAB 86-01. All slides must be in PDF format and submitted to the course Moodle by 8AM the day of your presentation.
